

Background

- Denmark: In clinical use, a model predicting 1 year mortality after surgery for colorectal cancer to stratify patients to various forms of prehabiliatation
- Based on Danish OMOP-data

Florence added Norwegian omop data

 New model built on OMOP harmonized data from both Denmark and Norway with the use of federated learning.
